BARN RULES

All visitors and guests must fill out required forms.

Horses are flight prey animals. They can be unpredictable under certain circumstances. By following the rules below, we can help enable our, as well as their, comfort and safety.

1. Appropriate footwear (closed hard toe shoes) must be worn when leading, hauling, grooming and riding.
2. Helmets are required for all riders taking lessons. A helmet-waiver must be signed by all other riders who do not wear helmets. This facility recommends all riders of all levels and ages wear a helmet when handling, grooming and riding.
3. Horses must be attended at all times when out of pastures or paddocks.
4. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult. No running up to or around horses.
5. **NO SMOKING** and no alcohol consumption while handling or riding any horses on the premises.
6. Dogs **MUST** be restrained on a leash and immediately removed from the premises if barking or interfering, scarring horses or horse owners.

ARENA RULES

Arena Hours: 9am to 5pm

1. Maximum Capacity: Indoor Arena 2 Horses, Outdoor Arena 6 Horses
2. Hourly use is by pre-approval only, with current vaccination proof. Guests for hourly use must register in the office to fill out required forms. (Fee is per hour not use)
3. Helmets are required unless a waiver has been signed.
4. Be aware and respectful of other riders: especially beginning riders, young or green horses.
5. Lessons and Boarders have priority- please yield to riders taking lessons.
6. **NO SMOKING** and **NO ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION** while handling or riding any horses on the premises.
7. Please scoop after use.
8. Close all gates, be safe and have fun!
