JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Our Working Students will assist our head trainer as necessary. Responsibilities may include catching and grooming horses, tacking and untacking horses, cleaning tack, sweeping barn, mucking stalls, picking pens, feeding, holding horses for vet and/or farrier, minor vetting, bathing and clipping horses.*

*warming up/cooling down depending upon skill level

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

Must have basic knowledge of safe horse handling and daily horse care; at least two years of riding experience.

COMPENSATION

Working Students will receive lessons based on the number of hours worked at the rate of \$10 per hour; lessons will be catered to individual needs and may include longe line/seat lessons, horsemanship and flat work.
